Notice to all Citizens of the Town of Chesterfield Community:

The Town of Chesterfield has been awarded funds through the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control State Revolving Fund (SRF) for a "Gravity Sewer Inflow and Infiltration Study" of the Town's sewer system. The study involves flow tracking using state of the art methods with electronic reporting equipment, manhole inspections and documentation, sewer line cleaning, sewer line videos and smoke testing to identify the sources of the excessive inflow and infiltration ("I & I") overloading the existing system. The "Study" will identify and quantify the location and source of I & I, allowing the Town to plan for future repair and / or replacement of the aging sewer infrastructure. In the coming weeks you may see our contractor's personnel on the streets and/or Town rights-of-ways in neighborhoods all around Town. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact Town Hall.

In addition, a portion of the funds has been allocated for the installation of "Emergency Standby Generators" at the County Jail sewer pump station and at the Chesterfield / Ruby Middle School sewer pump station. The need for standby power at the jail is self-evident in that during extended outages, inmates and staff must remain at the jail. The need for standby power at the Chesterfield / Ruby Middle School is that this school serves as a shelter during community emergencies, providing shelter and food for displaced citizens.

SRF programs operate around the country to provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our valuable water resources.
