INVOCATION.

Fire Chief White opened the meeting with prayer.

PUBLIC COMMENTS.

Mrs. Leonard addressed Council regarding soccer program.

MINUTES were unanimously approved by Council for July 8, 2021.

ANNEXATION. Ordinance 2021-5. Goodale Road.

On motion by Mr. Bittle, second by Mrs. Myers, Council unanimously approved Ordinance 2021-5 on second reading to annex property of Kayla S. Tyndall on Goodale Road.

FINANCIAL REPORT. Update.

The financial report was given to Council for July 2021.

FIRE. Updates. Grant, physicals & training.

Fire Chief White informed Council that firemen had taken physicals, two members were taking firefighter training and the VSafe Grant equipment had been delivered.

HALLOWEEN. Trick or Treat.

SEWER. Buchanan Bridge.

Administrator Taylor informed Council that the SC Emergency Management was reviewing the bid for the sewer line destroyed by the hurricane and was working on two options to cover the overage cost of the bid.

SMOKING. Anti-smoking Ordinance 2021-7.

On motion by Mr. Bittle, second by Mrs. Myers, Council unanimously approved Ordinance 2021-7 on first reading to ban smoking indoors for non-residential property.

SOCCER. Agreement.

On motion by Mrs. Myers, second by Mr. Bittle, Council unanimously approved the Soccer Agreement for Copeland Park.
